

We provide opportunities to inspire their creativity, stimulate their intellect, and introduce them to broader possibilities for their future. Our cultural excursions, creative workshops, art scholarships, and one to one mentoring nurture big dreams and encourage higher education and career planning.

Through exposure to the arts and positive role models we help these most at-risk youth build confidence, acquire life skills, and identify new interests, as well as improve their academic performance. Culture For One's programs deliver sources of motivation that these young people need to thrive ... not just survive.

#### **ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS**

We are proud to report that we now have 59 participants in our Arts Scholarship Program, taking place at the following locations:

#### **CREATIVE ARTS WORKSHOPS**

In 2021, throughout our foster agency partner residences, 1,100 youth participated in 153 Arts Workshops in therapeutic art, creative storytime, acting, creative writing, and podcast production.

#### FAMILY ARTOGETHER PACKAGES

The Family ArTogether Program is a "shared art experience" designed for foster children and birth parents or foster parents to bond over literature and visual art. The program was designed for children who are transitioning from a residence to a foster home, as well as for birth parent visits to their children living in residences.

The newly expanded program includes teens living in foster homes, a group particularly hard hit by the isolation the pandemic created. We will send out 700 Packages this year, compared to 150 last year!

## NEW PARTNERS & CULTURAL CONNECTIONS



- A new partner, City Living NY, refers young adults who have aged out of care to us; we arrange career exploration meetings and mentoring opportunities to support them as they approach independent adulthood.
- CFO is one of 50 NYS non-profits invited to take part in a new two-year program with the Theater Development Fund (TDF) called the Passport Series. As a participant, we have access to deeply discounted Broadway and off-Broadway performances, meaning more youth and families/caretakers can experience the magic of live theater.
- We are providing our programs to two new Good Sherpherd Services residences, The Brooklyn Youth Reception Center and Mcglaughlin East Harlem Residence.
